Purpose of Grant: Rural Development funds will be used to acquire equipment which will enable tele-mental health consultations to occur between and among psychiatrists, physicians, and other clinicians and persons needing services. Additionally, expanded continuing professional education, crisis services, psychological assessment, clinical supervision, and family psycho-education opportunities will be included in the program. An association of 32 private, community-based non-profit mental health organizations will participate. The program is expected to serve an estimated 125,000 children, adults and families.
